Public Transport

Train

A short walk from Central or Town Hall will take you directly to Darling Quarter and Tumbalong Park, Town Hall and Central Stations are a 10 minute walk from ICC Sydney. For further train timetable information and trip planning, visit <http://www.sydneytrains.info/>

Sydney Light Rail

The Light rail travels through a number of Darling Harbour stations including ICC Sydney's stops, Convention Centre and Exhibition Centre. Bus
